A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE NEW KENT COUNTY HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE CHARTER

WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors adopted resolution R-19-23 on July 13, 2023 approving the charter for the New Kent County Housing Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the New Kent County Housing Advisory Committee was created to perform an analysis of the current state of housing in the County, and develop recommendations to address any issues that may be identified; and

WHEREAS, the New Kent County Board of Supervisors desires to expand the membership of the committee to include a representative of the Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the New Kent County Board of Supervisors hereby amends the New Kent County Housing Advisory Committee charter as follows:

Charter

The Committee shall will be known as the "New Kent County Housing Advisory Committee" (the Hereafter "Committee").

<u>Purpose.</u> The Committee's purpose is to serve as an advisory committee to the Board of Supervisors. The committee will work with County staff to make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors to address issues of housing affordability and safety.

<u>Public Body.</u> The Committee is a public body for the purposes of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act.

<u>Duration</u>. The Committee <u>will shall</u> serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.

Membership. Each District Supervisor shall may appoint two (2) members to the Committee. In Addition, the Committee shall may also consist of one representative from the New Kent County Board of Supervisors, one representative from the New Kent County Planning Commission, one (1) Representative from the New Kent County Social Services Department, one (1) representative from the Virginia Department Health, one (1) representative from the New Kent County Building Development Office, and one (1) representative from the Planning Department. The New Kent County Administrator or his/her designee shall will also serve on the Committee.

<u>Duties of Committee</u>. The Committee will perform an analysis of the current state of Housing in New Kent County and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors to address any issues that may be identified.

Officers. The Committee *shall will* have three (3) officers: a Chairman, a Vice Chairman, and a Secretary. The Committee *shall will* elect the Chairman and Vice Chairman, and the Secretary of the Committee *shall will* be the County Administrator or his/her designee. Each officer *shall will* serve a one (1) year term that expires on December 31st.

<u>Duties and Powers of Officers.</u> The Chairman <u>shall will</u> preside at all <u>Committee</u> meetings, make Committee appointments, and <u>shall also</u> carry out other duties as may be assigned by the Committee. The Vice Chairman <u>shall will</u> perform any of these duties in the Chairman's absence or incapacitation. The Secretary <u>shall will</u> keep the records of the Committee.

Meetings. Regular meetings of the Committee shall will be held as needed at a time and place determined by the Committee Chairman.

Quorum. A majority of the members of the Committee shall constitutes a quorum.

Voting. All decisions shall must be made by a majority of members present and voting.

<u>Procedure.</u> Except as otherwise specified, proceedings of the Committee <u>shall will</u> be governed by the most recent <u>version of</u> Robert's Rules of Order, <u>Newly Revised</u>.

Subcommittees and Working Groups. The Chairman shall will appoint a chairman of all subcommittees established by the Committee within thirty (30) days of each that subcommittee's creation. The chairman of each subcommittee shall will then appoint the members of that subcommittee. Before becoming members, the subcommittee chairman's appointees will must be approved by need a majority vote of the Committee.

<u>Fiscal Year.</u> The Fiscal Year of the New Kent Housing Advisory Committee <u>shall will</u> run from July 1 through June 30.

<u>Required Reports</u>. The Committee <u>shall will</u> present periodic reports of the Committee's activities to the Board of Supervisors as requested.

<u>Amendments.</u> Any <u>suggested</u> amendments to the Charter <u>shall</u> <u>must</u> be <u>submitted to</u> <u>approved by</u> the Board of Supervisors <u>for approval</u> <u>before taking effect</u>.

Effective Date. The Charter is effective upon passage.
